GOALS & OBJECTIVES

1. To understand the history and reasons for ligidus arthrodesis in HAV correction/stabilization of the medial column. Treatment rationale including biomechanical considerations for ligidus correction/use of hardware
2. To identify, diagnose and treat plantar plate ruptures. To understand and identify the pathology involving plantar plates ruptures including operative management.
3. An overview of distal Achilles tendinopathy & retrocalcaneal pathology with emphasis on surgical management.
4. To understand the benefits of surgical vs conservative treatments of proximal 5th metatarsal fractures
5. To understand the indications and surgical techniques involved with fusion of the medial column in patients with stage III and stage IV PTTD.
6. Overview of the indications and surgical techniques for the filet of toe flap for treatment of plantar forefoot diabetic neuropathic ulceration.
7. To understand the rationale involved with choosing a surgical procedure in a systematic, evidence based practice when treating hallux limitus/rigidus.
8. To be able to diagnose syndesmotoc injuries and choose method of surgical repair as well as understanding the functional anatomy of the syndemosis.
